

## **2018 FACULTY AWARD**

The Faculty Award singles out that faculty who, in the opinion of his or her colleagues, has contributed outstanding service to the University, such as through leadership activities, mentoring faculty colleagues, or exemplary dedication to students. Our 2018 honoree is a physicist with a distinguished record of internationally recognized research in nuclear science. He has published more than 215 papers in refereed journals and given more than 100 invited presentations at national and international meetings and conferences since joining the Notre Dame faculty in 1982. His outstanding contributions to the University's educational mission have been recognized with a Kaneb Teaching Award as well as the Terrence Akai Award for Exceptional Service to International Students. He has served colleagues and students alike on bodies ranging from the University Committee on Diversity to the Faculty Board on Athletics. And while these and other instances of his leadership have greatly benefitted Notre Dame, he has also been an active contributor to the broader physics community, bringing heightened visibility to our nuclear science program in the process.
