This year's winner of the Rev. Paul J. Foik, C.S.C., Award for significant contributions by library faculty joined the Hesburgh Libraries in 2011 as a subject specialist librarian for Latin American, Iberian, and Latino studies and quickly became a valued resource within the libraries and the wider University community.
