

2019 FACULTY AWARD

The Faculty Award singles out that faculty member who, in the opinion of his or her colleagues, has contributed outstanding service to the University, such as through leadership activities, mentoring of peers, or exemplary dedication to students. Over the past three decades at Notre Dame, this year's recipient has advised some 30 graduate students as well as more than 100 undergraduates and won teaching awards at both levels. An internationally recognized expert in stream ecology, he devotes considerable time to mentoring junior faculty colleagues. He served as chair of the Department of Biological Sciences for six years during a period of strong growth and developed the initial vision and design of the Notre Dame Linked Experimental Ecosystem Facility, or ND-LEEF, which he then directed for two years. He is currently director of the University's GLOBES program, an interdisciplinary graduate certificate for students with interests in environmental, global health, and sustainability research.
