2022 RESEARCH ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The Research Achievement Award honors a distinguished faculty member who has made significant contributions to scholarship in his or her discipline and to the research and graduate education goals of the University. The recipient has made seminal and sustained contributions to geospatial and environmental fluid dynamics through novel modeling, laboratory experimentation, and field research across multiple scales. He has advanced our understanding of phenomena at the intersection of hydrologic, atmospheric, and ocean sciences, with applications at nearly every level, from city planning, to domestic and international policy, and to our shared understanding of our changing world. With an exceptional legacy of international scholarly eminence, he is both well published and oft cited, and he is a mentor to the next generation of scientists and engineers. He has received many honorary doctorates in recognition of his work. Other distinctions include being elected a fellow of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, the American Physical Society, the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the American Meteorological Society, and the American Geophysical Union.
