During the workshop, you will explore and apply a variety of practices to enhance student learning in your courses. Upon successful completion of the workshop, you will be able to:

- Apply the backward course design process for more effective student learning
- Describe and implement inclusive teaching practices.
- Plan engaging activities for your classroom.
- Describe the culture of teaching and its evaluation at Notre Dame.


